Check out the Bermuda Musical and Dramatic Society. From Shakespeare to full-scale musicals such as 'Jesus Christ Superstar', or classics such as 'A Streetcar Named Desire', BMDS has been there, done that, and printed a T-shirt. The Society stages some five or six shows a year at its Daylesford premises, and puts on its annual Christmas production at the City Hall Theatre, and also has a choral group called the Daylesford Singers, which performs annually.

But if all you're after is a convivial atmosphere, good friends, tons of social events including golf tournaments, holiday and special event get-togethers, Open Mic "Hoot" nights, Giant Jenga in the bar (yes, GIANT JENGA), movie nights, quiz nights, sing-alongs, BBQs, or a stint behind the bar, BMDS has that too. It is, in short, a membership club for trained and untrained amateurs with an interest in all aspects of theatre production and stage management or just having a good time with friends. Membership is open to all and comes with many perks, not the least of which is having the opportunity to purchase tickets for any show prior to being offered to the general public.

The Society's facilities are available to all members, any of whom can put forward suggestions for a play or presentation of some kind in Daylesford's 120 seat theatre. Some productions, such as the annual Christmas Pantomime, are also mounted in the larger City Hall Theatre. Whilst BMDS shows generally are of a very high standard, thanks to the wealth of expertise which the Society has built up over the years, members of all levels of ability are actively encouraged to try out for shows, whether actors, technicians or production assistants. Training workshops in the various branches of theatre, both artistic and technical, are organised from time to time, and novices are always encouraged to take on a supporting position with more seasoned members during the run of a show, before being thrown in at the deep end on their own.
